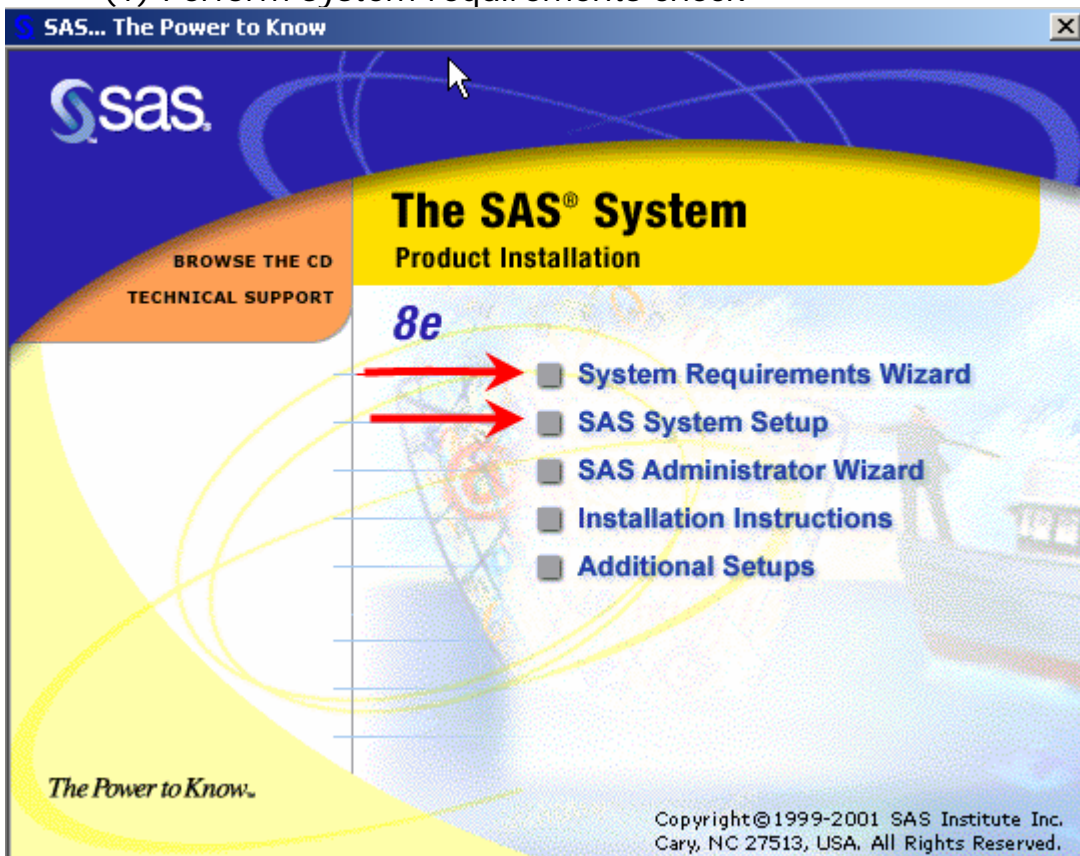

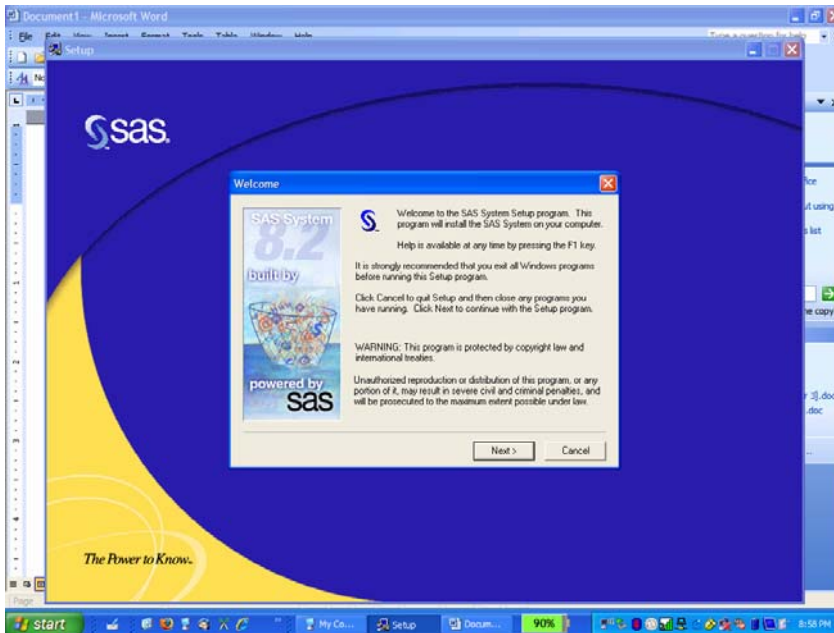
- Request a copy of the 'SAS 8.2 for Windows Workstation' license.

  - Perform system requirements check



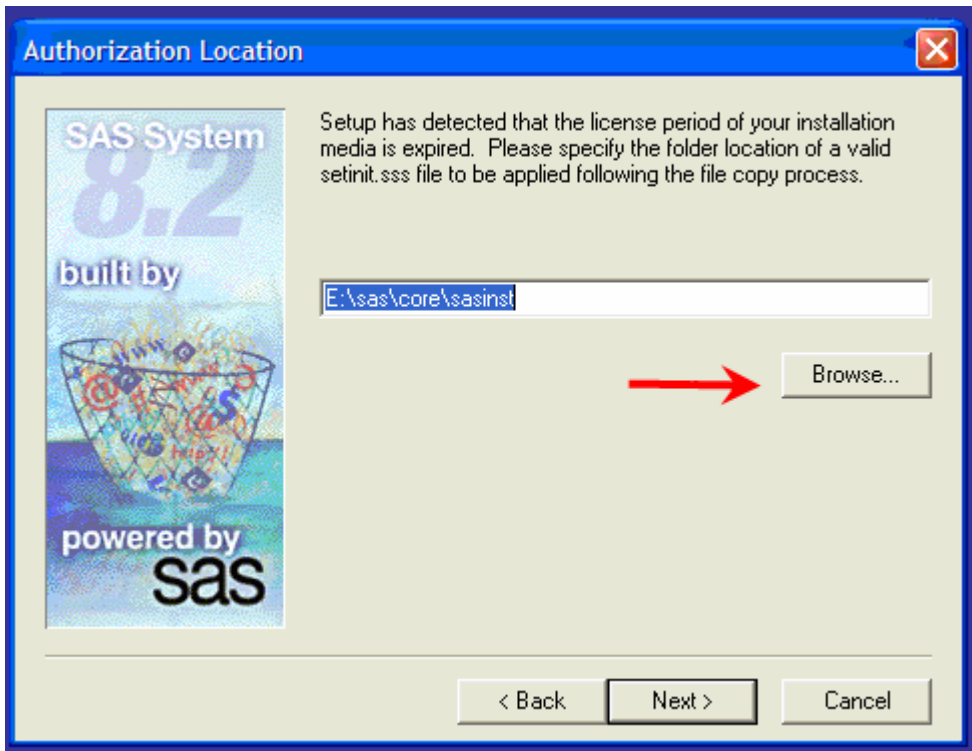
Reboot the computer as necessary

- Select SAS System Setup

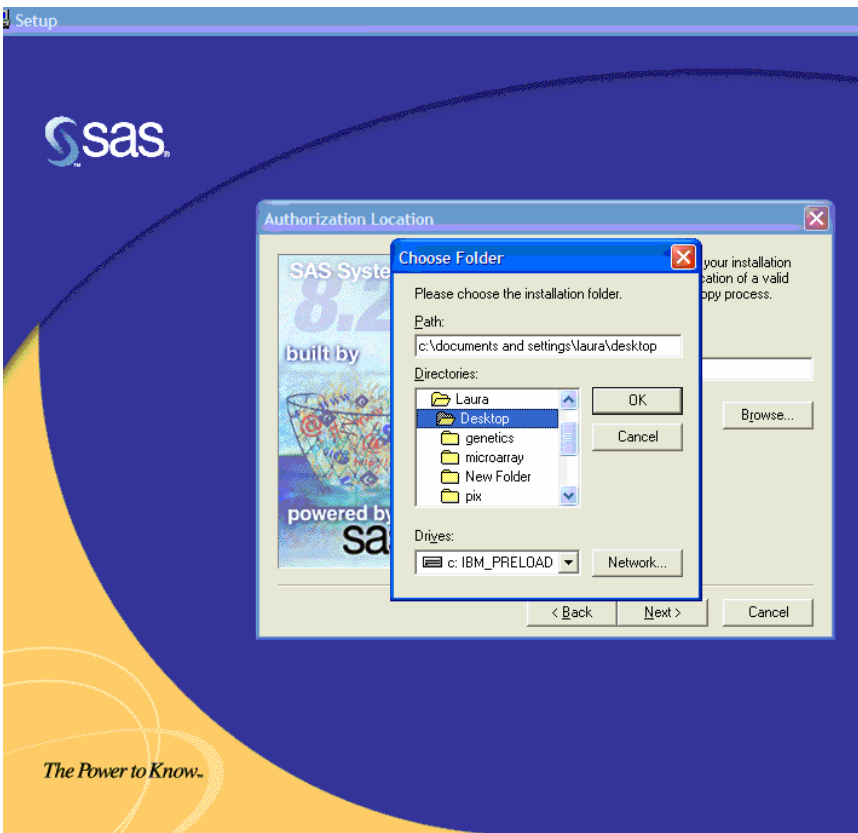
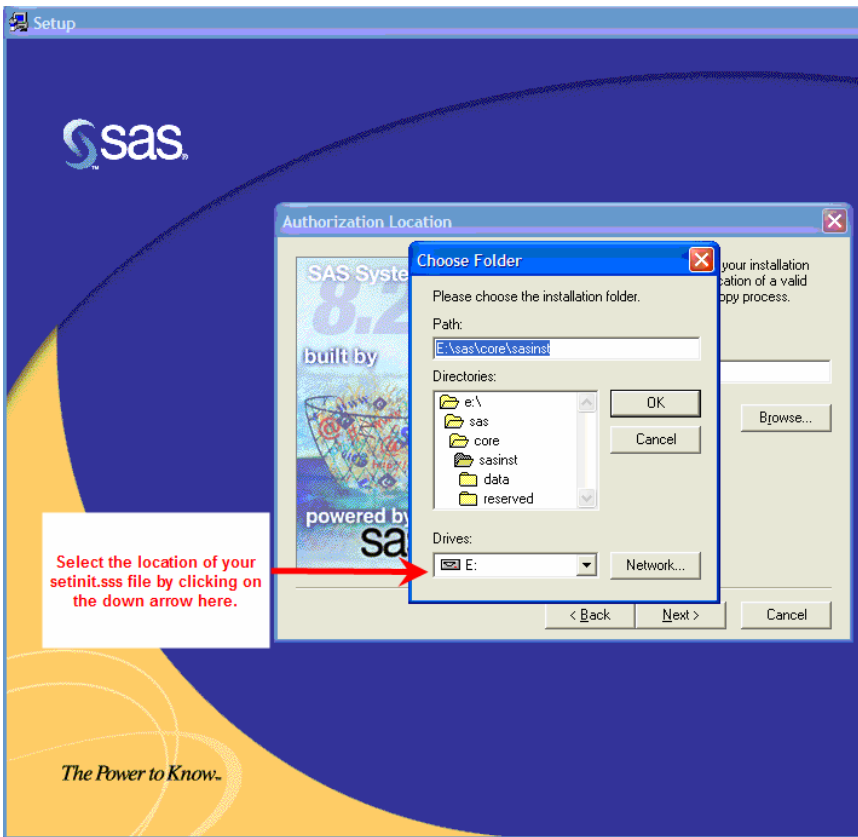
(3)Click Next



SAS install wizard will now detect that an expired license is on the setup CD and it will ask you to browse to a current license.



Specify the folder location of a valid setinit.sss ...  
Click on the Browse button and browse to your desktop (or wherever you saved the recently downloaded setinit.sss file).
