

Applying the Updated SAS SETINIT in the Microsoft Windows Environment for Release 8.2

Method 1

As instructed by the download page presented to you when you submit your request for a license update:

1. Save (or download) the file as setinit.sss. Remember to make note of where you are saving it.
2. Navigate to the location where you saved setinit.sss
3. Double click on the file and this should launch SAS. SAS will then apply the new license information

Method 2

As instructed by the download page presented to you when you submit your request for a license update:

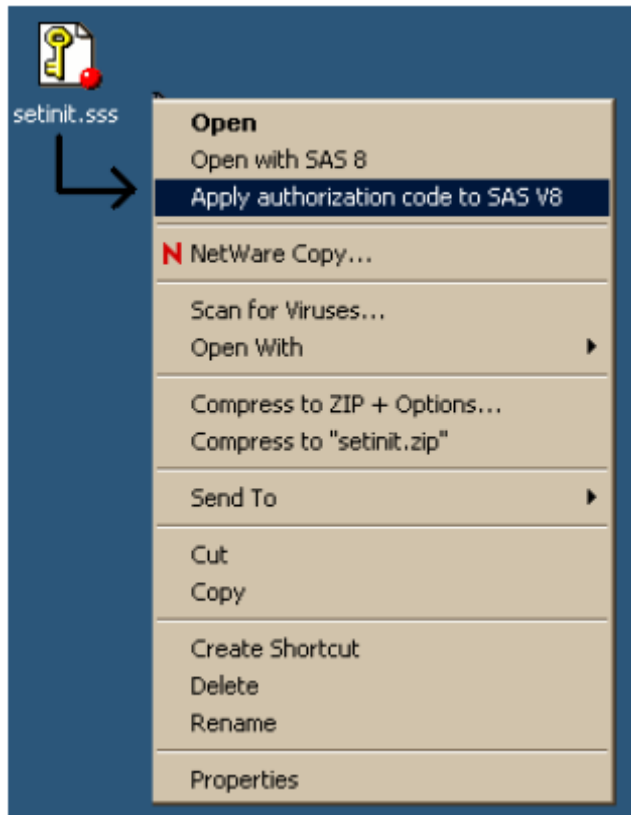
1. Save (or download) the file as setinit.sss. Remember to make note of where you are saving it.
2. Navigate to the location where you saved setinit.sss
3. Open the file in Notepad
4. Launch SAS
5. Copy the license information from Notepad into the Editor (or Enhanced Editor) window of SAS
6. Submit the code

Method 3

As instructed by the download page presented to you when you submit your request for a license update:

1. Save (or download) the file as setinit.sss. Remember to make note of where you are saving it.
2. Navigate to the location where you saved setinit.sss

3. Right Click on the file.



4. Select 'Apply authorization code to SAS V8' from the menu selection.
5. SAS will be invoked in batch mode, and the authorization code contained in the SETINIT.SSS file will be applied.
6. A SETINIT.SSS.LOG file will be created in the same location as the SETINIT.SSS file. You can check the log file to make sure the license has been updated. If your license has been updated correctly, you will see the following note in the log: Note: Siteinfo data have been updated.
7. You may copy the setinit.sss file manually to its default location if you choose to. This location is c:\Program Files\SASInstitute\SAS\V8\core\sasinst.
8. To verify your license information, submit the following code in your SAS Editor window:

```
proc setinit noalias; run;
```

The correct license information will be displayed in the SAS Log window.
